Announcement No. 1

The aim of the conference is to foster discussion on theories and practices, traditions and challenges in the education of preschool and early school-age children in Poland and worldwide. Contemporary times, due to increasing changes in various areas of human life, give rise to numerous dilemmas in children's education. Problems resulting from globalization, faced by modern educators, require continuous reconstruction of previous experiences, consideration of diverse perspectives and contexts, as well as responses to emerging challenges.

The conference, as a meeting of various communities, provides an excellent opportunity for social exchange of viewpoints, ideas, and innovative solutions.

The conference is addressed to:

1. representatives of academic communities (researchers, theorists),
2. representatives of educational institutions (teacher educators and professional development staff for teachers, educators, and child caregivers),
3. practitioners and innovative teachers,
4. directors of educational institutions,
5. founders of schools, kindergartens, and other educational institutions, as well as authors of educational programs and original classes,
6. educational policymakers, members of educational associations, and representatives of innovative pedagogical movements.

This year's conference will focus on discussions concerning inspiring and supporting child development from historical and contemporary perspectives, including global, technological, multicultural, and alternative educational theories and practices—both Polish and international—highlighting current trends and directions of change.

We also aim to emphasize the essence, meaning, and role of the child in theoretical explorations, as well as in proposed solutions and practices. During the two-day conference, we will reflect on child pedagogy in Poland and beyond. We will critically examine ongoing changes, reforms, innovations, and their social reception.

To ensure proper preparation for this debate, all updates regarding program changes, as well as the structure and schedule of sessions, will be published on Facebook and on the official website of the University of Applied Sciences in Leszno.
